

Year 3	In maths, the children will be moving on to learning more about multiplication and division; which will involve both mental and written methods of calculation. They will then apply these skills to a range of puzzles, words problems and investigations to test their understanding.	The children are continuing to enjoy our topic based around African Lions. Next week they will begin writing their own stories which will be based in Africa. We will be asking the children to apply all of the writing skills taught so far, as well as introducing some new skills, such as using emotive language, which will make their writing even more interesting to read.
