### Monies owed to the school

We are fast approaching the end of the academic year and we need to be making sure that all money owed to the school is settled in full. Parents and carers who owe money for school dinners, trips, after-school clubs provided by external parties and music lessons will be sent reminders on a regular basis and we expect the payment to be made. It is school policy that all paid-for provisions are settled in advance and the School Office should not be put under undue pressure to chase money from parents. You will be aware that School budgets are under extreme pressure as cuts are being made at Government level in funding for schools and the school therefore cannot subsidise school dinners, music lessons and other paid-for activities. If you have persistently not settled any outstanding debts then the school will be forced to pursue the small claims court route. We are happy to share with you that the majority of the school community is following school policy and appreciate as always your support in ensuring that school funds are indeed spent on the teaching and learning for our children.
