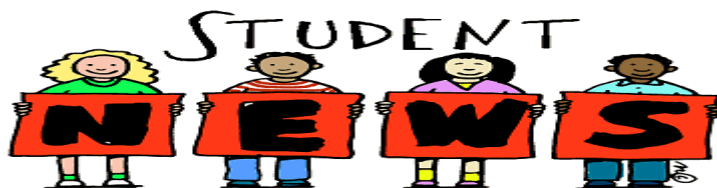

General Reminders

As we are settling into our new routine returning back to school we thought this was the ideal opportunity to just highlight a few items / rules we would like to children to be aware of.

* Children must not wear any jewellery during their PE lessons in school. This includes stud earrings. Please ensure that all jewellery is removed on your child's PE days - you can check with your child which days these are.

* Children are welcome to bring a snack to school for morning break. As a healthy school we do ask that you try to avoid crisps, chocolate bars, fizzy drinks & sweets. The snack should be kept in the child's class tray until break time - it must not be kept in the packed lunch box as children are not allowed to access the lunch trolleys during break.

* Please ensure that all of your child's clothing is clearly labelled with their name. We are already collecting a vast amount of lost property due to items not labelled! Unnamed items are stored in lost property baskets in the Upper and Lower School cloakrooms and you are welcome to look through them any afternoon; however on a Friday (weather permitting) they will be brought outside the cloakroom for easier access.

Year 3	Next week in Lower School, we will be concentrating on place value and the number system in maths.
