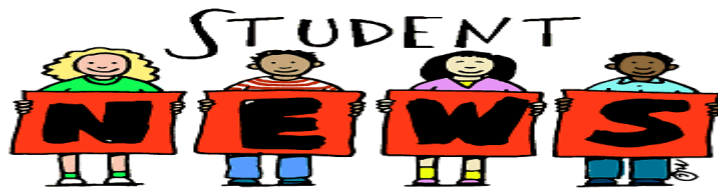

Next Week's Learning

w/c 08 th Oct	Maths	Literacy
Year 3	Next week in Lower School, we will be starting our maths unit on addition and subtraction mental methods. Year 3 will focus on partitioning to add and Year 4 will be finding more or less than a given number. Children will be asked to complete arithmetic and fluency questions and will then move on to problem solving challenges.	In English, the children will be looking at the features of diary entries and learning about past tense verbs. They will then start to collect ideas about 'a day in the life of a WW1 soldier', in preparation for writing their own diary entry in a couple of weeks.

Year 5	In maths, year 5 will be learning how to efficiently add and subtract using mental methods whereas the year 6's will be moving on to using written methods for addition and subtraction. As always, the children will apply their skills to a range of different contexts.	In English the children will be continuing to experiment with persuasive techniques which they will then apply to a persuasive letter at the end of the week. The letter is based on our class book 'War Horse' which the children seem to be thoroughly enjoying.
