Year 3	In maths, the children will be continuing their learning on the formal written method for subtraction. They will complete fluency questions to practise the methods they have been taught and will then apply this knowledge to solve real life maths problems.	Next week, the children will continue to learn about the role of animals in World War One. They will use the facts they have found to write sentences about how animals supported our soldiers in the war effort. Both year groups will be learning about formal language and year 4 will also learn about subordinate clauses and different forms of punctuation they may use in their non-chronological reports.
