

Welcome to Ross Class!

Welcome to Ross Class! Mrs Kehoe and Mrs Ashby are excited to begin the new year with some exciting learning experiences to enjoy.

This Autumn, our topic will be WWI, we will be acknowledging the commemoration of 100 years since WW1 as a class and joining the whole school for a variety of activities. 'Life in A Trench' will be central to our learning, we will learn WWI songs, learn about the role of animals on the front line. As always we will have a class reading book that we will share together 'The Trenches' by Jim Eldridge, a wonderful story of friendship and the lives of soldiers in a WW1 trench. We will learn about how horses were influential in helping with the war effort as well as other animals that helped out during the war.

During the Spring term, our topic will be The Bronze Age: we are excited to be going to Flag Fen to experience what life was like during this era. A WOW day is planned to include: farming, building roundhouses, pottery, and making spears. The children will compare the lives of Bronze Age people and the modern day. As a class, we will create our own settlement, with each class member having their own job! Our Class book will be an adventure book about a boy called Tenko who is a stranger to Skara Brae, 'The Boy with a Bronze Axe' by Kathleen Fidler.

The Summer term will see us learning about The Romans.

Our Maths lessons will start with working through the 4 operations learning and recapping how to add, subtract, divide and multiply mentally and using the formal written method. As the year progresses we will move onto fractions, measures, and shape. We will strive to do our best. Learning times tables is a goal for year 4. In the Spring term, we will be introducing Times Table Rockstars to help achieve our goal of learning all of the tables.

Our Science will be learning about skeletons and diet, Rocks and Soils, Electricity, and the States of Matter.

In Year 4 the children will have the chance to go to Kingswood, our fantastic 2 night residential on the North Norfolk coast. The children have the chance to participate in various outdoor activities and have fun with their friends.

As part of Year 4, the children will have 6 weeks of swimming and they will have 6 sessions of Forest School with Mrs Grange in the school paddock, where they will build on the skills they learned in Year 3. The children will also continue to learn Italian with Mrs Prezioso, and PE with Mr Clark our Sport Coach. In the Spring term, the children will have an opportunity to learn to play the recorder.

Homework will be given out on Fridays and is due in on Thursdays. Please encourage your child to do the challenge questions set. If they wish, they may attend the weekly homework club to complete their homework.

Children will be lining up in the morning on the playground and will be going into the classroom to complete their morning activity at 8:40am. They will be collected from our classroom at 3 pm.
