We are starting this year by studying the topic of World War 1. This year marks the 100 year centenary of the First World War and we will be remembering all of those that gave up their lives. We will be reading the book War Horse by Michael Morpurgo where we will explore the thoughts of Albert Naracott from the events that transpire by keeping a diary. Our focused for maths will be on the four operations (+ - ÷ ×) and we will learn to apply knowledge to longer word problems.

As we move into Spring, our topic changes to America. Our class book is Holes and we will explore the conditions of Camp Green Lake. The children will take part in a 'Detention Day' at the start of term before a celebratory party at the end to celebrate Stanley's release from the Correction Facility. Our maths focus will be fractions and applying this knowledge to percentages and decimals.

Space will be our topic for the summer term. We will investigate the planets and our solar system whilst reading the book Cosmic. Our summer term trip will take us to the National Space Centre in Leicester where we will have an in-depth look at all things space! The children will also get a chance to go on the Year 5 residential, Bushcraft, in Broughton Woods. We will apply all of our maths knowledge in the summer term, also covering area and perimeter and shape.
