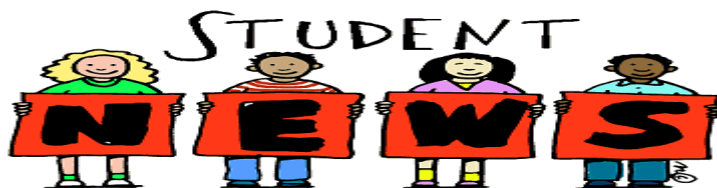

w/c 03 <sup>rd</sup> June	Maths	Literacy
Year 3	In maths, year 3 will be focussing upon 2D shapes and year 4 will be calculating area and perimeter.	After half term, the children will start looking at story writing. They will look at a good example (a WAGOLL) of a narrative text before they start collecting together ideas for writing their own story about the Roman Invasion.
Year 4		This week is also our 'Inter-faith week'. As part of this, our children will be visiting a Sikh Gurwara and will be learning about the Sikh religion.
Year 5	Year 5 will be going through their most recent assessments in maths and revisiting previous learning to develop the understanding of key skills.	In English both year 5 and 6 will be learning about biographies so they will spend the week reading and analysing a range of biographies and will then begin to create a fictional character related to space travel in preparation for their own.
