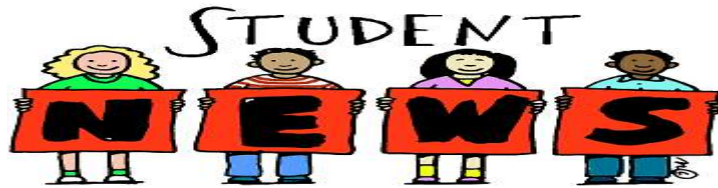




# St Augustine's Junior

### Book Fair

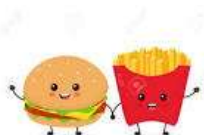
We would like to thank everyone who came and supported our book fair before half term. We managed to raise an impressive £580 which gave us £286 worth of books for the school.

### Country Dancing

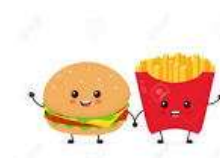
