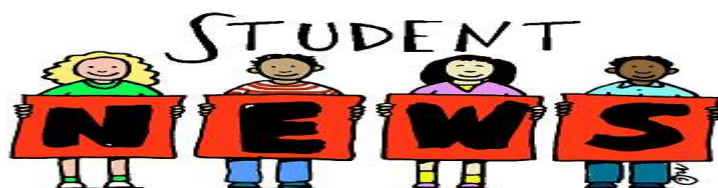

Year 3	In maths, the children will be continuing their learning about angles and applying this to a range of questions and problems. They will be learning the appropriate maths vocabulary to describe angles, using words such as: right angle, acute angle and obtuse angle.
