<b>Year 3</b>	Year 3 will be exploring how to read, write, compare and order numbers using place value knowledge. Year 4 will continue to build on the place value knowledge that they have already learnt to help them count and sequence in multiples.	In Lower School, the children will be using their trip to Old Hunstanton to support their understanding of figurative language. They will be using these skills to begin our work on a detailed setting description.

<b>Year 5</b>	Our children will answer place value questions linked to decimals in different contexts such as money and measures. The children will also begin to recognise Roman Numerals.	In English, our Year 5 and 6 children will be beginning to write the introduction of their non-chronological report. The children will explore different ways to begin their piece of writing and evaluate these so that they have an engaging and informative introduction.
<b>Year 6</b>	The children will work on problems that involve rounding to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000. They will also round decimal numbers to the nearest whole digit.
