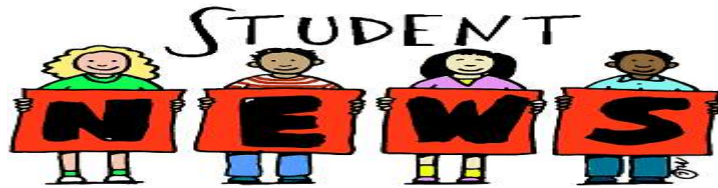

We are very proud to be a Church School, and have strong links with our local church. If a parent wishes to withdraw their child from Collective Worship, our policy states that they arrange a meeting with myself to clarify the elements of worship are objected to, and to agree alternative provision for the child during this time.

Year 3	Lower School will be completing their work on Place Value this week. Once they have finished, they will start looking at mental methods of addition and subtraction.
