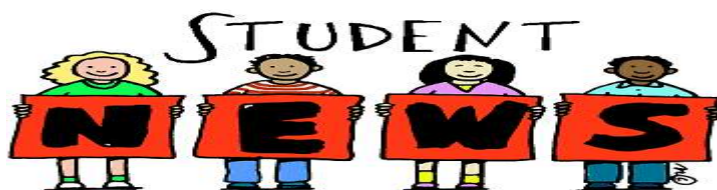

Year 3	In Maths, we will be continuing our work on the four operations, starting with addition. We will be looking at using both the formal and informal method, deciding which method is more appropriate for different questions.
