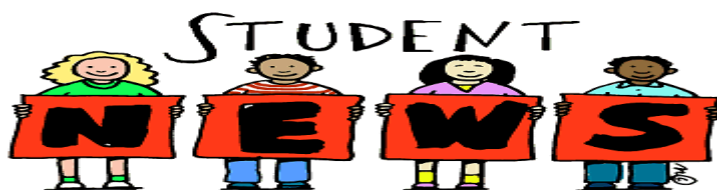

Year 3	Year 3 will be looking at formal methods for addition and subtraction over the coming weeks. They will be learning and practising the new methods through fluency and reasoning tasks.	In Lower School, the children will be continuing their narrative unit. We will be visiting the River Nene and exploring our senses, which will help us to set the scene for our own short stories based around the Michael Morpurgo book 'This Morning I Met a Whale'.
Year 4	Year 4 will be revising how to add numbers mentally, using different methods.
