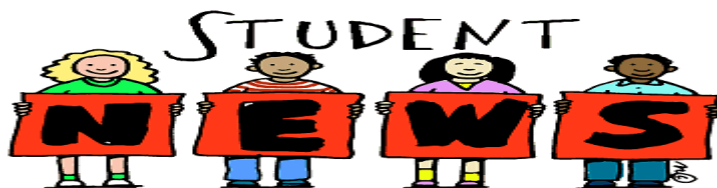

Year 3	Both year groups are continuing to learn/master the different methods to add and subtract larger numbers.	Lower School will be continuing to work on the skills needed to write a short story. They will be using their knowledge of figurative language and differing sentence types to write descriptive and emotive sentences. They will also be learning how to use inverted commas to convey speech, which they will use in their story to talk to the whale.

Year 5	In maths, after first looking at prime numbers, factors and multiples this week, Year 5 will choose an appropriate method (mental or written) to complete questions using division and multiplication.	We will start writing their own poems after creating imagery using writing features such as: onomatopoeia, metaphors, personification and similes.
Year 6	In maths, the children will compare decimals, fractions and percentages and complete problem-style questions using their knowledge.	We will begin the narrative unit where they will analyse their WAGOLL and begin to write parts of their story.
