Year 3	In Maths, Y3 and Y4 will be learning how to read and plot coordinates in order to create a picture!	Next week Year 3 will be in the spotlight with their 3 Nativity performances next week. During the rest of the week, Lower School will be writing their own version of the Nativity Story from an alternative perspective.

Year 5	Year 5 will be continuing to practice formal written methods of division. They will apply their knowledge in answering problem-style questions, ensuring they fully explain their answers.
