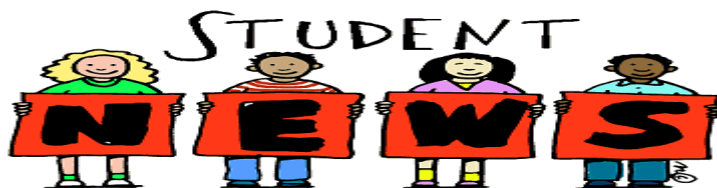

<b>w/c 24<sup>th</sup> Feb</b>	<b>Maths</b>	<b>Literacy</b>
<b>Year 3</b>	Year 3 will be revisiting formal multiplication.	After Half Term Lower School will use their Talk for Writing skills to Analyse and perform a Non-Chronological Report about the Vikings. We will be visited by an educational company to immerse the children into a Viking Experience. This experience will support our research and understanding of the Vikings.
<b>Year 4</b>	Year 4 will be starting their work on fractions.	
<b>Year 5</b>	Year 5 will use their knowledge of fractions to work out fractions of amounts. They will complete fluency and problem-solving style questions.	In English, both Year 5 and 6 will analyse the features of formal and informal letters before writing an informal letter. They will write a letter in role as Eliza, complaining about how she is being treated at Trumpton Hall to her father.
<b>Year 6</b>	Year 6 will finish off their work on calculating angles before using coordinates to describe position. Fluency and problem-solving style questions will be completed so the children can demonstrate their understanding.
