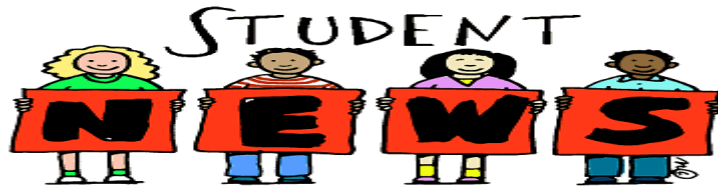

A Message From Mrs Pierce

We had a visit from Childnet on Tuesday. Although we discuss how to stay safe online a lot in school, it is always great to be able to welcome an expert in to reinforce this important safety message.

I hope that your child came home and talked to you about it, and showed you their "SMART RULES" as they all took a copy home.

S - keep your personal information **SAFE**

M - never arrange to **MEET** up with someone you only know online

A - do not **ACCEPT** links/adverts/friend requests if you are unsure of who has sent it.

R - find **RELIABLE** information online by comparing at least 3 different websites

T - **TELL** a trusted adult if something or someone ever makes you feels upset, worried or confused.

If you have not had a chance to have a conversation with your child about this yet, please try and do so over the weekend. It is so important that our children know how to stay safe online, and that they know what to do if they are worried about anything they see online.

Ellie also spoke with the children about the importance of being kind and respectful to others online and making the internet a better place by helping their friends if they are worried or upset by anything that happens online. I am afraid that recently I have had to speak to parents whose children have been unkind to each other online, and the parents concerned were unaware of this. I would ask that you monitor your child's use of the internet, and their mobile phones if they have one, regularly.

w/c 03 rd Feb	Maths	Literacy
Year 3	Year 3 will build on their knowledge of multiplication to learn how to multiply large numbers using the formal written method.	In Lower School, Year 3 and 4 will be finishing their own set of instructions on 'How to Train Your Dragon. They will focus on using imperative verbs, adverbs and adjectives to edit and improve their instructions. In English, Upper School will continue their biography topic. The trip to Burghley House on Monday will enable the children to find out further information about King Henry VIII as we watch him go on trial.
Year 4	Year 4, they will be learning how to divide using the formal written method.	
Year 5	Year 5 will continue to work with fractions. They learn how to multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers, applying this knowledge to reasoning and problem-solving questions.	
Year 6	Year 6 will use their knowledge of shapes to work out the area and perimeter of different shapes. They will answer problem solving and reasoning style questions to practice applying this knowledge.
