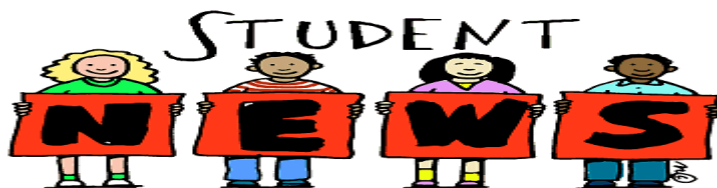

<b>Year 3</b>	In Maths, Year 4 will be solving problems with fractions, whilst Year 3 will use their time to consolidate their understanding of written multiplication.
