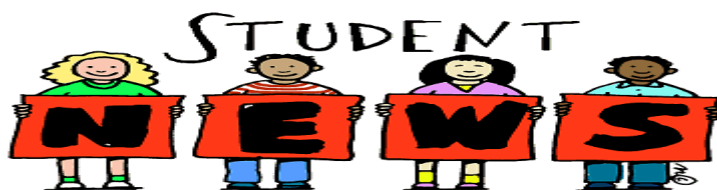

## Learning for Next Week

<b>Lower School</b>	<p>For the past two weeks, the children in Lower School have been using the book 'Here we are' by Oliver Jeffers to assist their transition back to learning. They have been completing tasks across the curriculum, including writing poetry, estimating sizes, exploring food chains and a number of other activities.</p> <p>Next week, the children will be finishing our transition topic completing more cross-curricular tasks related to the book. As part of the transition, children have also been taking a number of small assessments to inform the learning they'll receive throughout the Autumn Term.</p>
<b>Upper School</b>	<p>The book 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers has been the main focus of the last two weeks of learning in Upper School. We have completed tasks from across the curriculum such as writing formal letters, persuasive speeches and poems; exploring biomes with a focus on the biome we live in; and completing maths activities all based around the book.</p> <p>Next week, our final week using 'Here We Are', will see the children write descriptions and complete other cross-curricular tasks. As part of the transition back into classroom learning, the children have also been completing a number of small assessments to help inform the teaching that they will receive throughout the Autumn Term.</p>
