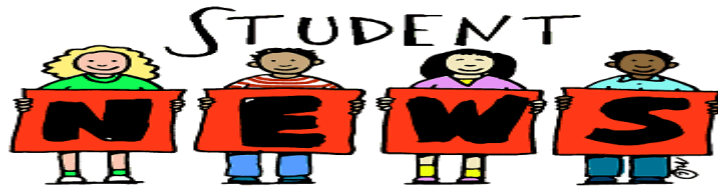

A Message from Mrs Pierce

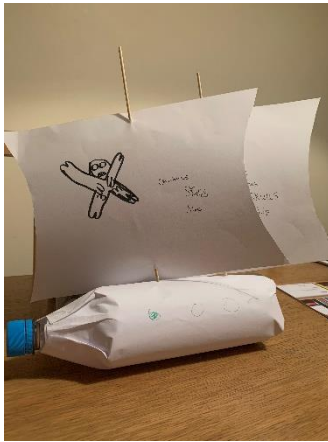

Learning for Next Week

w/c 12 th Oct	Literacy	Maths
Lower School	In Year 3 and 4, the children will be practising the skills needed to write a set of instructions on how to make a Stone Age drinking pot. They will learn how to use a rhetorical question to entice a reader and how to use imperative verbs to command.	<p>In Maths, the children will be finishing their place value unit.</p> <p>Year 3 - will be recognising place value in numbers - using concrete manipulatives and pictorial representations to support their understanding.</p> <p>Year 4 - will be comparing and ordering numbers beyond 1,000. They will also revisit finding 100 and 1000 more than a number.</p>
Upper School	In Year 5 and 6, the children will apply the skills they have learnt over the last two weeks to write an effective journalistic recount on the outbreak of World War 2.	<p>Year 5 - will move onto rounding decimal numbers to the nearest tenth or whole number. They will continue to complete fluency and problem solving questions whilst practising times tables and arithmetic daily.</p> <p>Year 6 - will move onto completing addition problems using both mental and written methods. The children will also complete arithmetic and times table work daily.</p>
