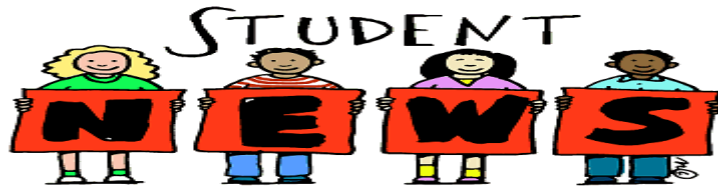

Lower School	<p>The children will be completing their set of instructions on how to make a drinking vessel in the Stone Age. They will be applying the skills that they've learnt over the past two weeks to enhance their writing.</p>	<p>Year 3 will consolidate their learning of place value by responding to any marking, completing extension tasks and a mini place value assessment to assess the impact of the unit. They will continue to practise arithmetic skills throughout the week.</p> <p>Year 4 will be comparing and rounding numbers and investigating problems during reasoning sessions. They will continue to practise arithmetic skills throughout the week.</p>
Upper School	<p>In English, Upper School will be starting their new writing unit which is diary writing - they will complete a mini-write and then break down the WAGOLL to identify the features and techniques used within diary writing.</p>	<p>Year 5 will be moving onto mental and written methods of addition. They will continue to apply their place value knowledge to ensure they are careful with their addition calculations.</p> <p>Year 6 will move onto mental and written methods of subtraction completing fluency and problem style questions. Daily arithmetic and times table practise will also continue for both year groups.</p>
