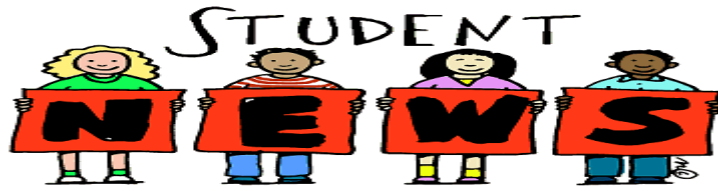

## A Message from Mrs Pierce

As a new lockdown begins, I wanted to take the opportunity to remind you that for us in school, it is business as usual. The government is clear that attendance at school will remain compulsory during this lockdown, and although our risk assessment procedures continue to work well, I do have staff in school who are potentially vulnerable and are unable to work at home this time around, so please help us to keep everyone as safe as possible by continuing to:

- 1) Leave your child at the entrance gates in the morning if at all possible to avoid congestion on the playground.

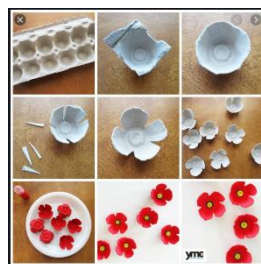

### Learning for Next Week

w/c 09 <sup>th</sup> Nov	Literacy	Maths
<b>Lower School</b>	In Lower School, the children will be researching information about the Bronze Age. They will be using the Non-Chronological report WAGOLL to support them in exploring how the people of the Bronze Age lived.	<p>Year 3 - will continue to consolidate their learning in addition using partitioning. They will be using a range of questioning to support their understanding, including reasoning and problem solving.</p> <p>Year 4 - will be exploring how to add 3 and 4 digit numbers using the formal written method. Both year groups will be continuing to practise their arithmetic skills throughout the week.</p>
<b>Upper School</b>	Upper School will continue work on writing a formal letter of complaint. The children will take their informal letter that they have written in role as an evacuee and change their complaints into formal writing. Their perspective will also change, they will write their formal letter from the viewpoint as a parent of an evacuee.	<p>Year 5 - will be looking into mental and written methods of multiplication. They will apply their times table knowledge in a range of problem solving questions.</p> <p>Year 6 - will be completing SAT style assessments in maths (both arithmetic and problem solving) as well as assessments in GPS and reading.</p>
