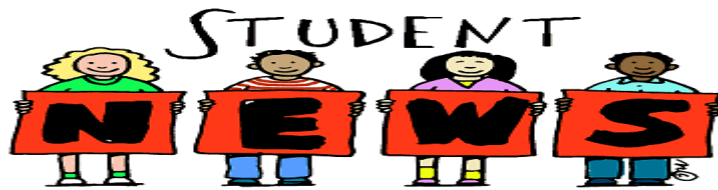

Learning for Next Week

Lower School	<p>The children in Lower School will be completing their Autumn Term Assessments next week. This includes a reading assessment and a SPAG test, which will focus on grammar, punctuation and spelling, including a separate spelling test. Year 3 will have an arithmetic test and a reasoning test with year 4 having the same including an additional reasoning paper. These assessments will be used to support the teaching of English and Maths for the remainder of the Autumn Term and into the Spring.</p> <p>Year 3 will use the rest of the time in the week to focus on their Christmas Nativity. They will be rehearsing scenes and learning songs within their bubble.</p> <p>Year 4 will continue to explore how the bronze age changed the way that settlers lived.</p>	
Upper School	<p>Year 5 will be completing assessments next week. These will include an arithmetic paper and two reasoning papers in maths along with a reading paper, a grammar paper and a spelling test. These assessments will help teachers to identify what needs to be a focus in the coming weeks. In addition to this, Year 5 will finish off their formal letters by editing and improving them.</p> <p>Year 6 will re-visit and learn the written and mental methods of division. As usual, they will complete fluency questions along with a range of different problem solving style questions. After assessments last week, they will write and edit their formal letters in English.</p>
