

Phizz-Whizzing Roald Dahl

PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be learning about the names of different body parts. They will explore hygiene, including how to keep themselves clean as well as how to prevent the spread of illnesses.

French

In French, we will be continuing to build confidence with our numbers as well as learning instructions in the classroom and the names of common nouns.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at the importance of spreadsheets and how we can create bar charts and pie charts using information collated in a table.

Art

During our Art lessons, the children will be experimenting with paint to look at different types of stokes and how the blending of paint can create different effects. Within this, we will be exploring Van Gogh and his artwork.

English

The BFG will be our stimulus to write a poem about our own giants. They will be using their poems to support their writing of a narrative later into the term, which will again be influenced by the story of the BFG and our trip to the Roald Dahl Museum.



Maths

Fractions will form the basis of our mathematical learning this half term. We will be learning about tenths, recognising, ordering and comparing fractions and how we can use them. We will be learning how to add and subtract fractions with the same denominator as well as how to work out fractions of a whole.

Music

We will continue to explore different mediums used to create music, whilst appraising and listening to 'Three Little Birds' by Bob Marley.

DT

We will be using pneumatics to design, create and evaluate our own dreamcatcher, inspired by the BFG.

In addition, we will also explore the different human and physical characteristics of the UK, including the local River Nene.
