

# OPPOSITES ATTRACT

## PSHE

Through our Healthy Lifestyles unit we will be learning about how to keep ourselves healthy in mind and physically. We will be exploring different ways to keep ourselves healthy whilst learning the importance of dental and personal hygiene.

## French

We will be recapping and practising prior learning before moving onto the 'les animaux' unit about animals.

## Computing

We will be using online sites to explore coding and how code can be used to create action and movement.

## Art

Inspired by 'The Iron Man', the children will be exploring silhouette and creating their own artwork using this medium.

## English

In English, we will be reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes to inspire us to write a non-chronological report all about the mysterious being.



## Maths

2D and 3D shape will be the focus of the final term in maths. We will be recognising, drawing and creating shapes whilst also looking at the perimeter around a shape. In addition to this, we will be learning about acute, obtuse and right angles and linking this to shapes.

## Music

The children will have weekly sessions learning about pitch and sound using glockenspiels.

## DT

The children will be designing, making and evaluating their own robot, creating links to how it can have a purpose.

## RE

Our final RE unit will be focussed on the teachings of Islam. We will be specifically looking at the idea of submission and obedience.

## Geography

We will be recapping our geographical knowledge by naming and locating different counties of the world, including the continents they are in, before moving closer to home and exploring counties of the UK as well as identifying their human and physical characteristics.
